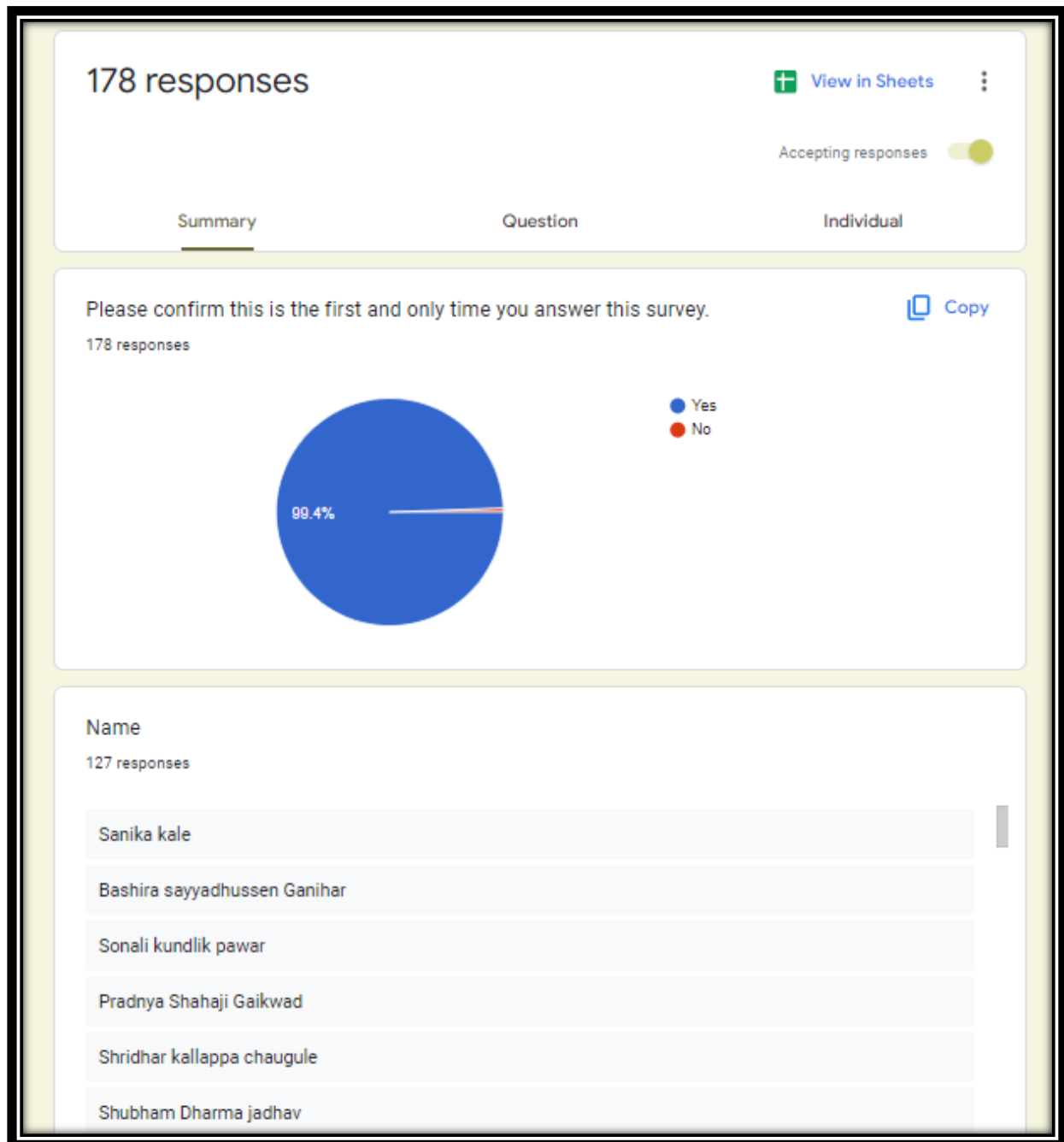

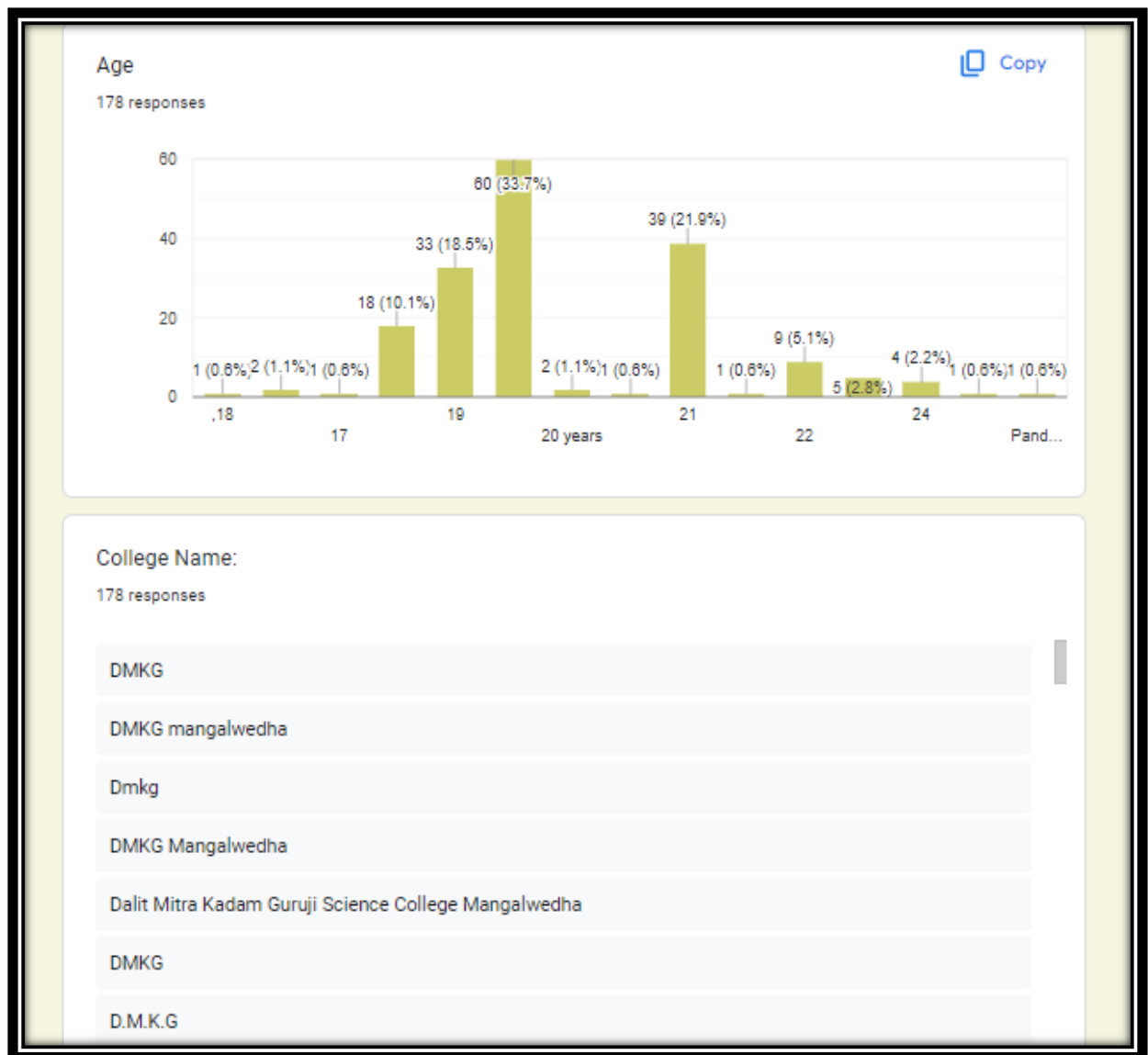

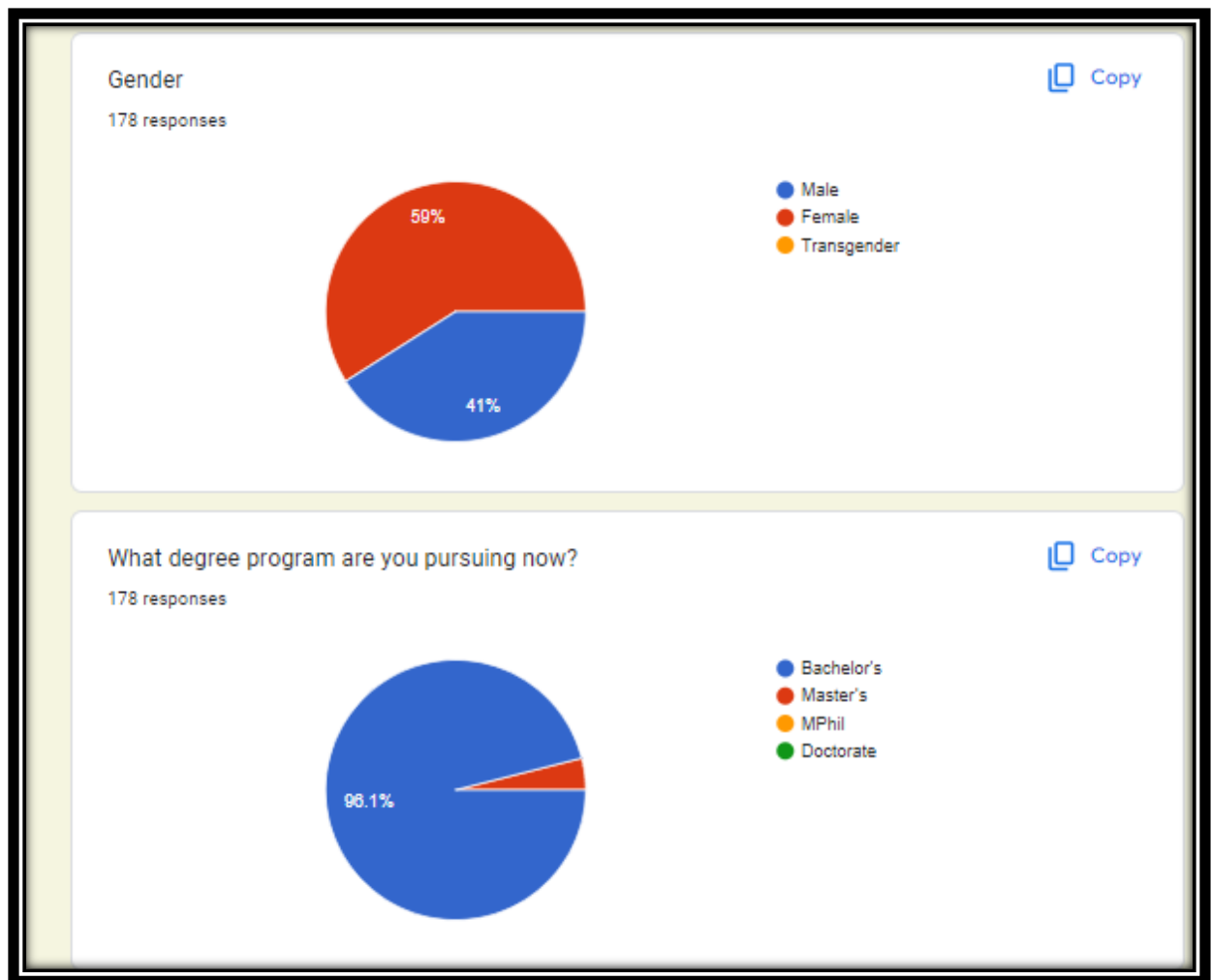

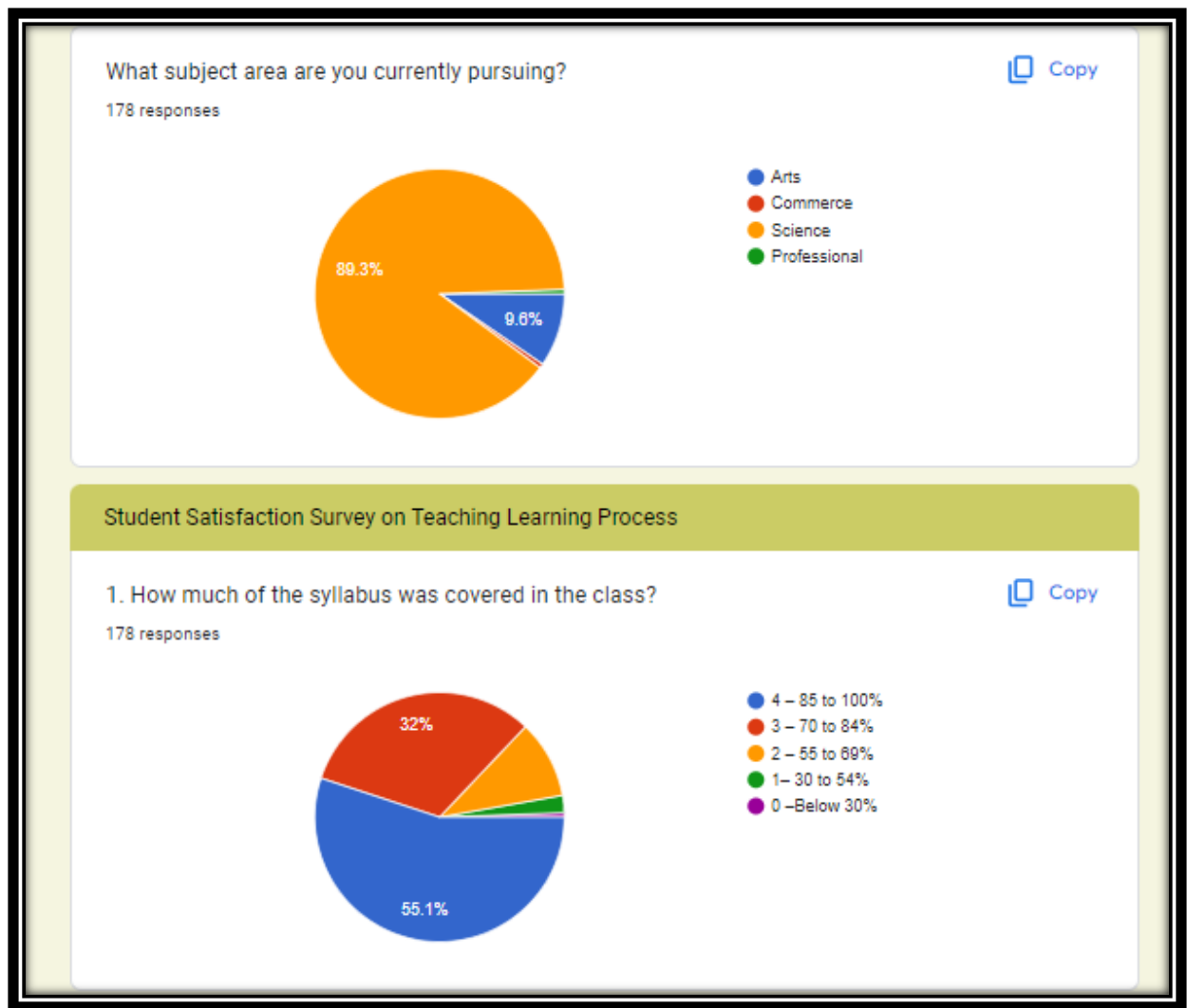

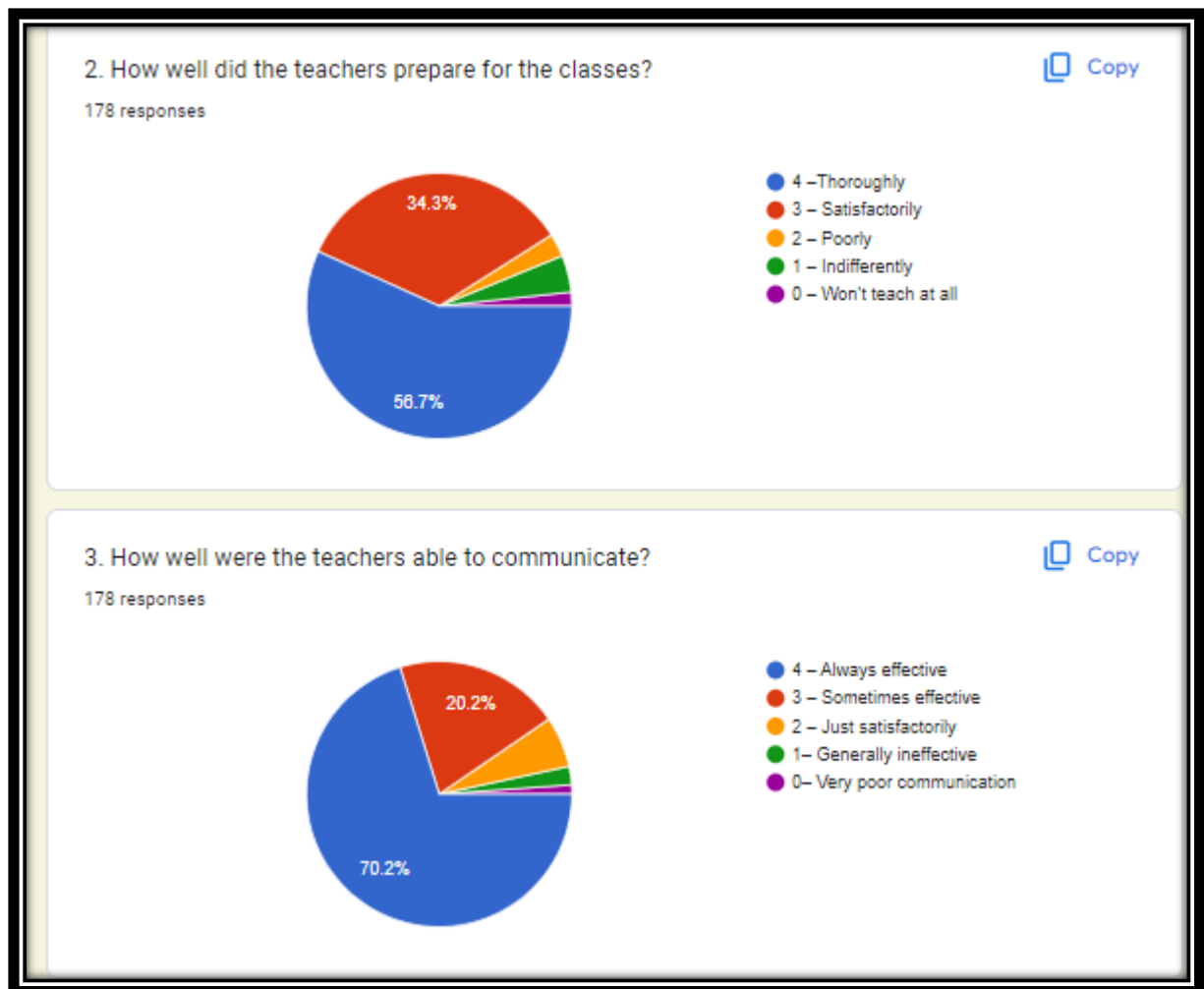
Above chart shows the age group of students in that 60 students have 20-year age and 33 students have 19 year of age 2 percent of student having 24 ages.



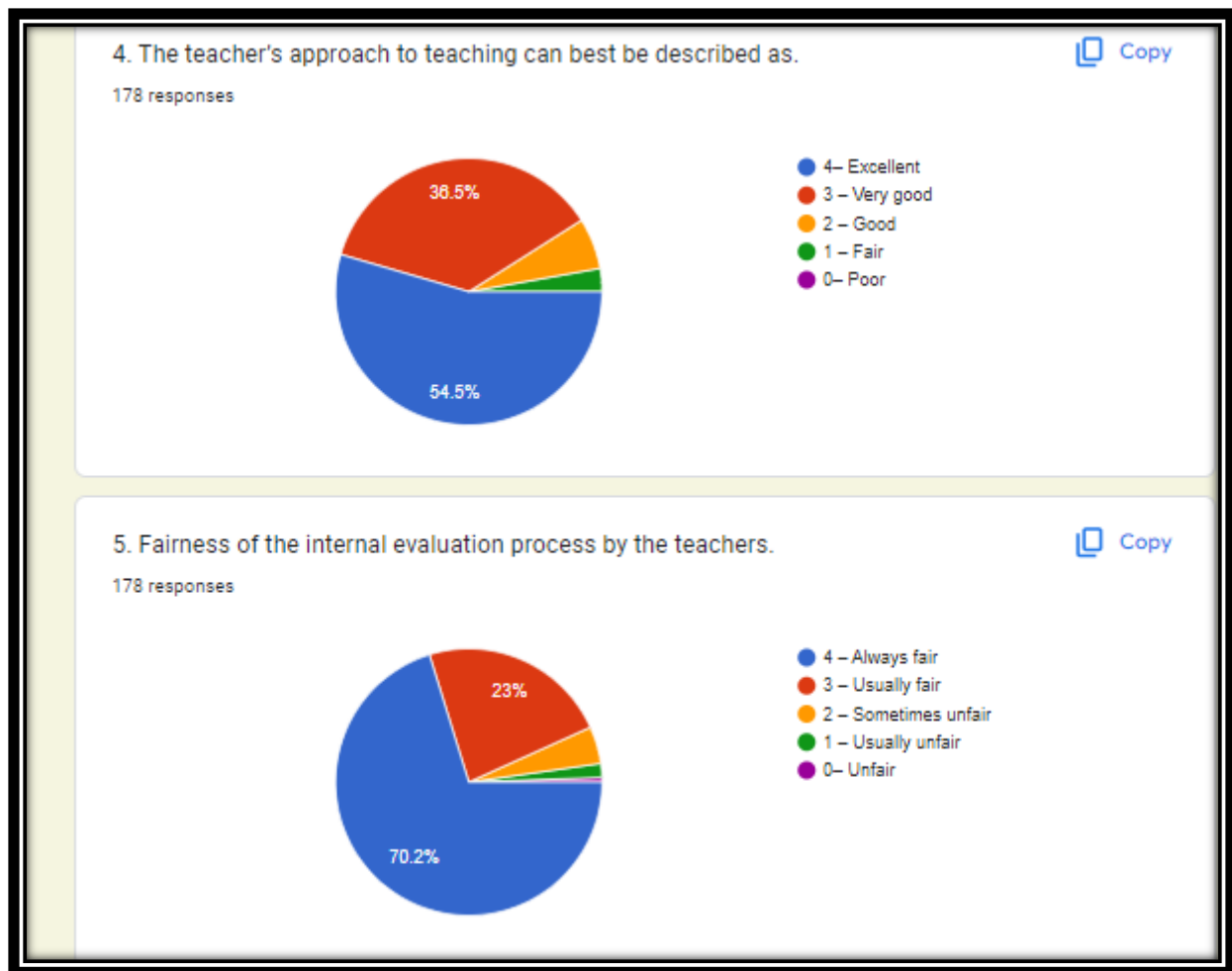
Above chart shows gender and program pursuing data in that there are four field we included, so 96.1% of student responded that they are pursuing bachelor degree.



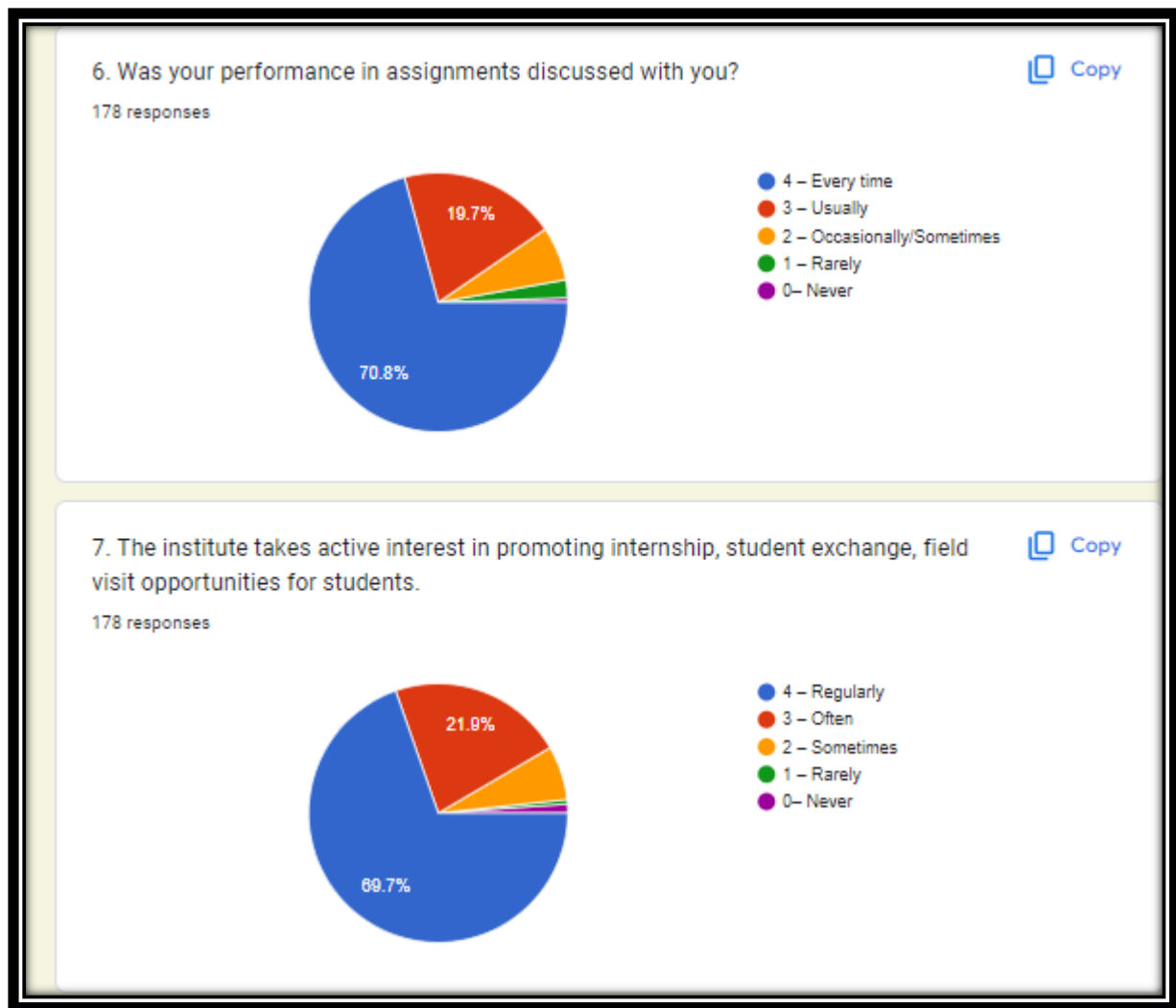

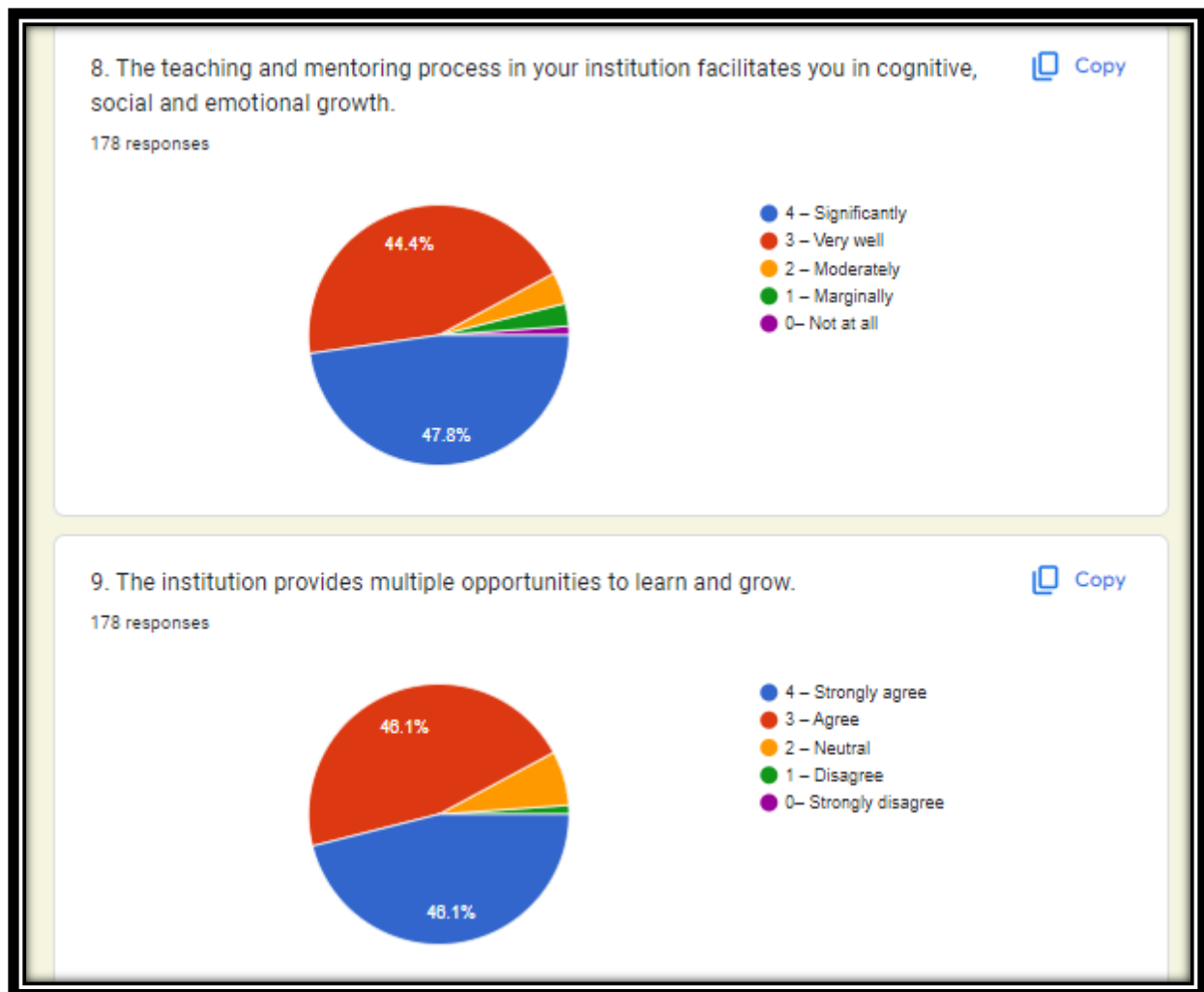

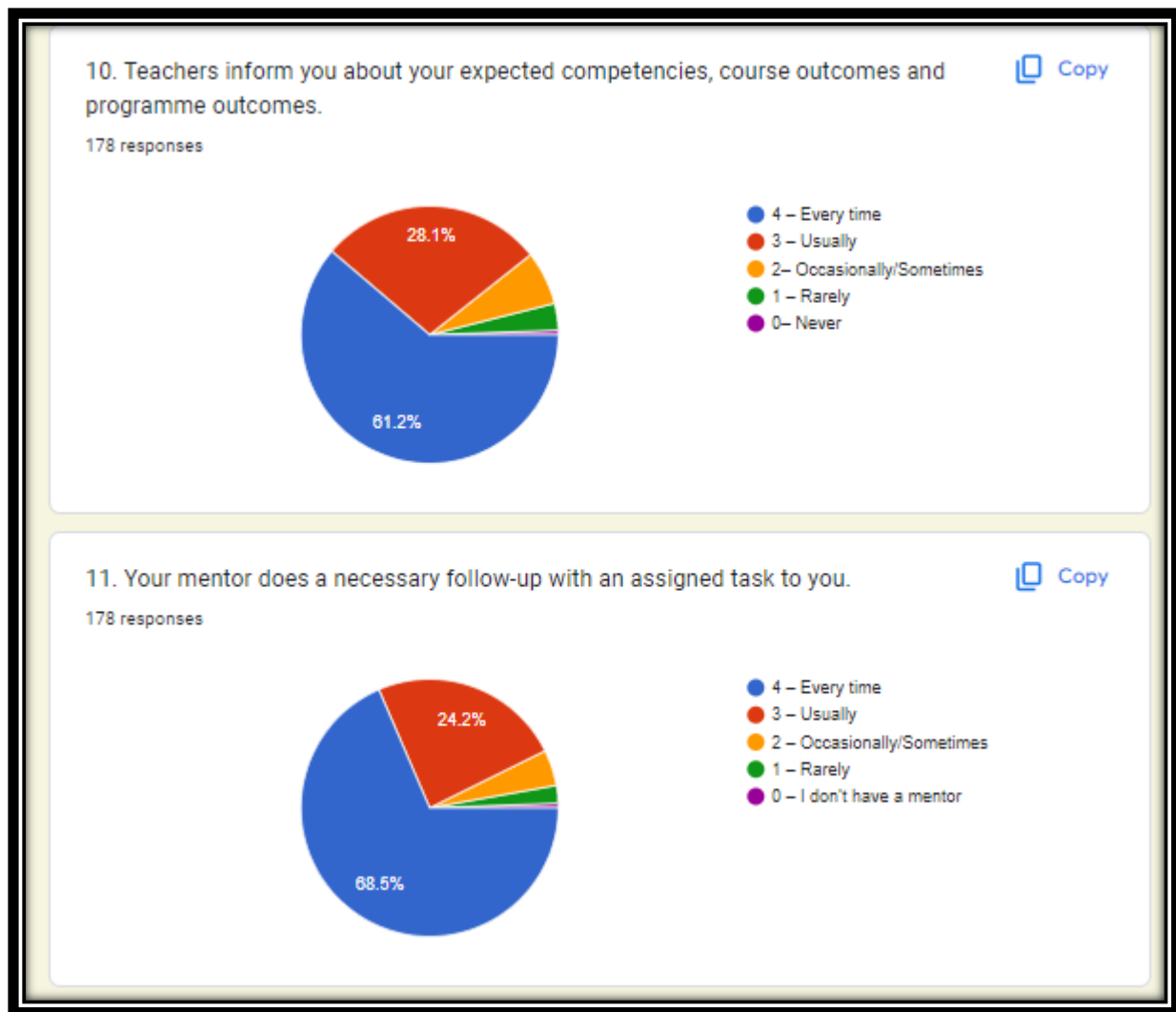

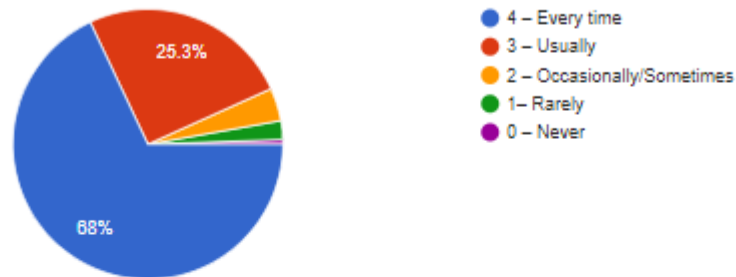

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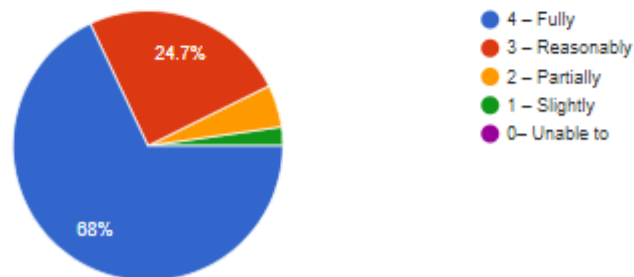

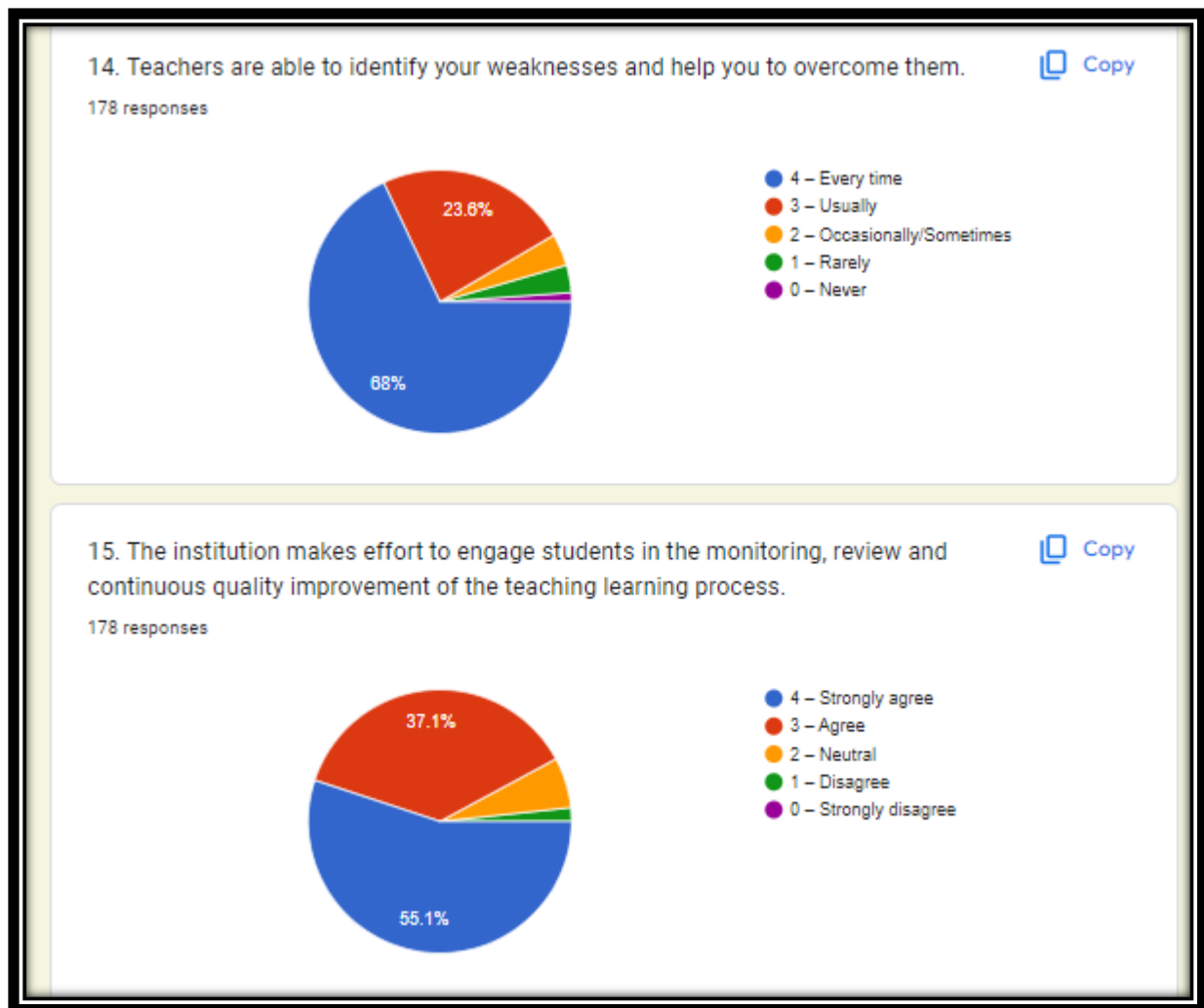

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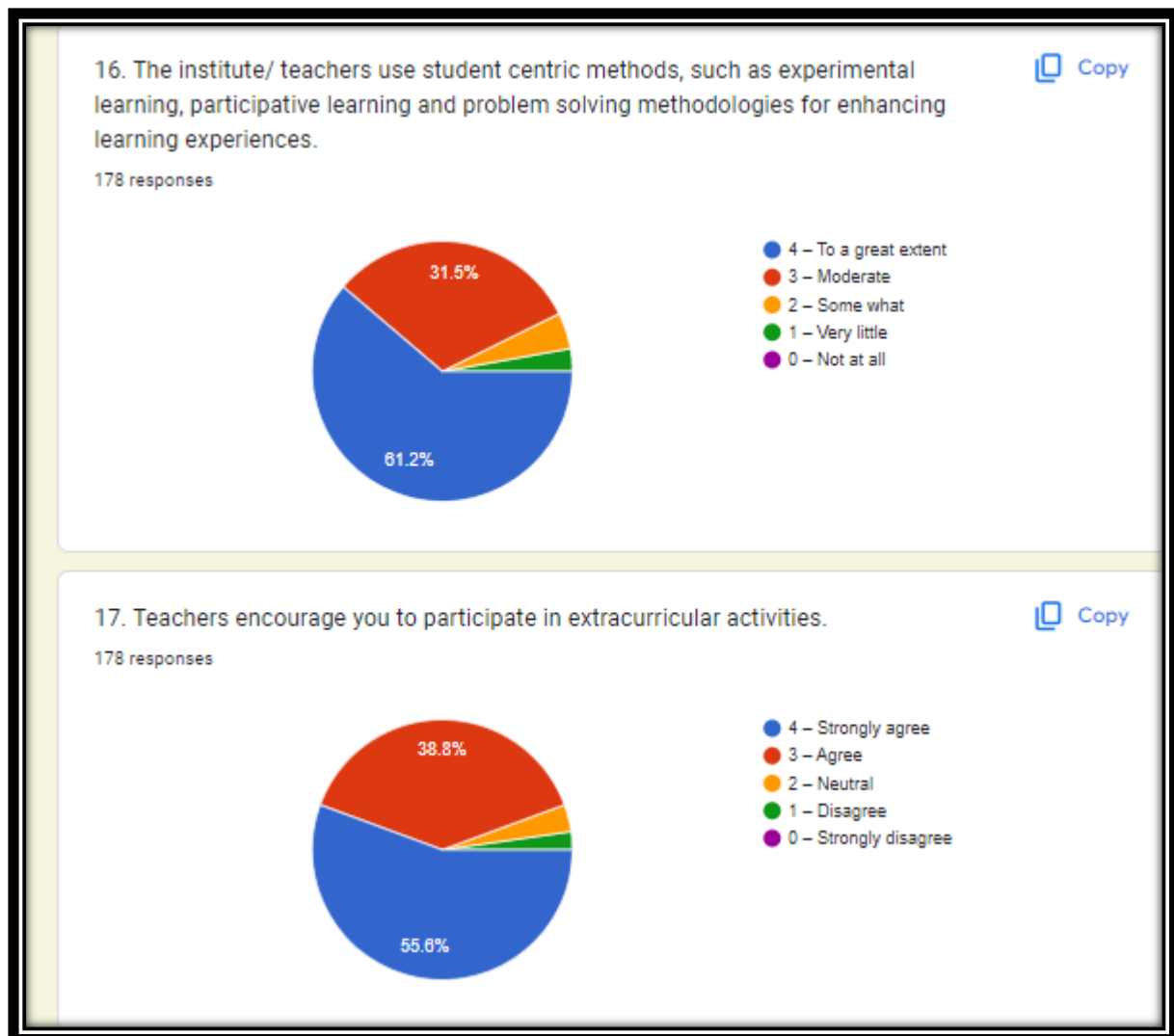

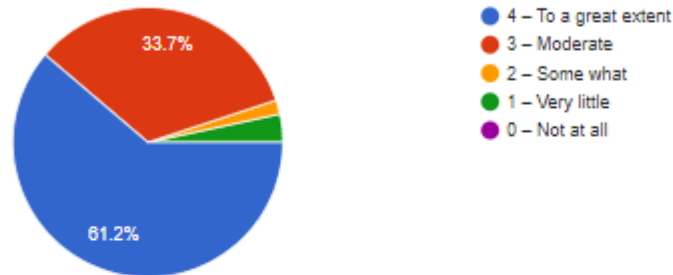

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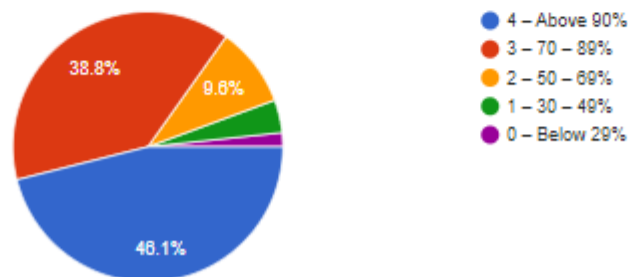

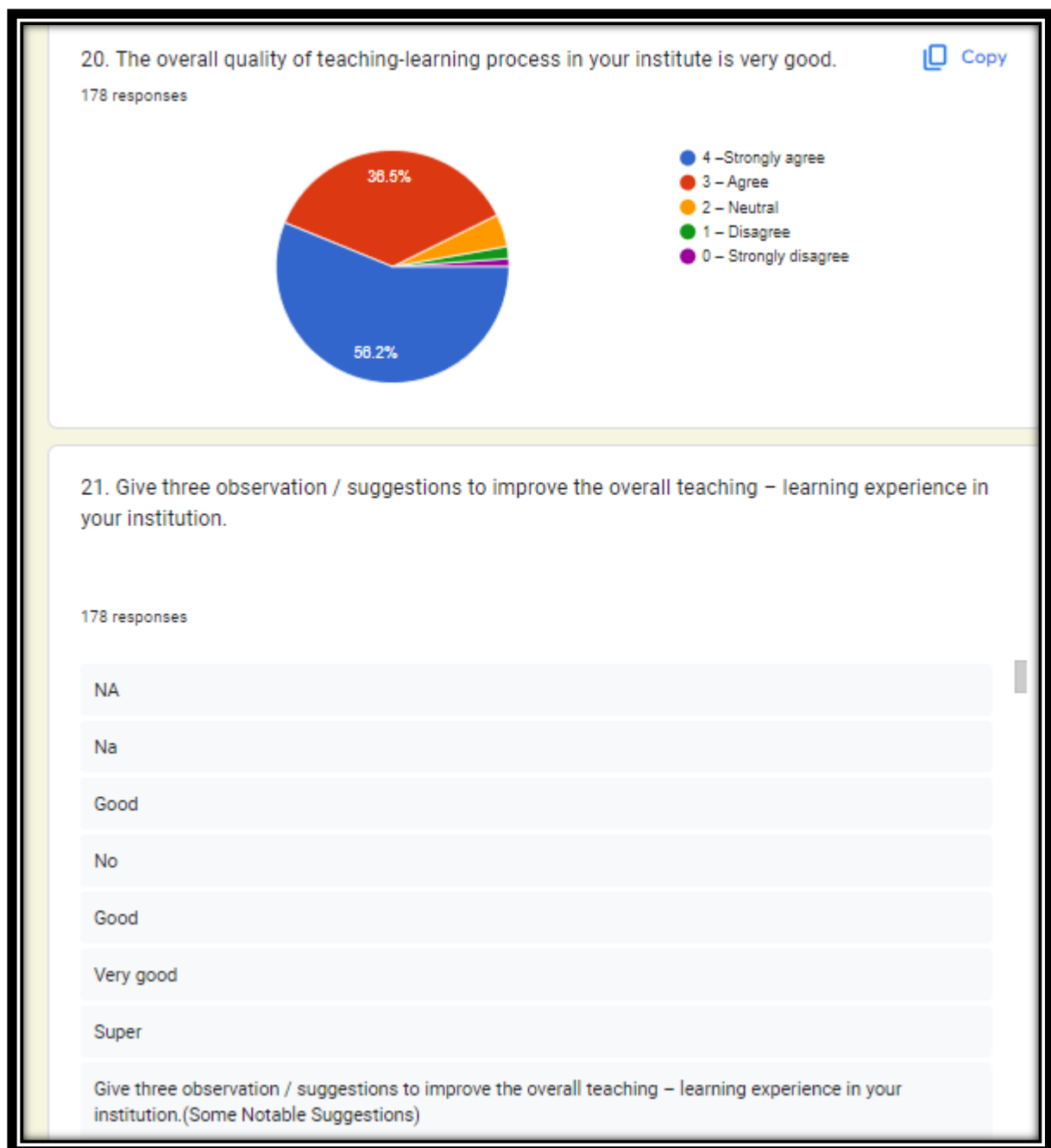
